## RULES AND GUIDELINES

### HOMEMADE FOOD COMPETITION CUM FOOD STALLS

1. **Items for stalls:** Homemade food (Only Vegetarian)
2. **Charges for stall:** NIL
3. **Number of participants:** 1 ( individual) per stall
4. **Rate for food items:** Participants will decide
5. **Reporting time at the venue:** 5.00 PM
6. **Furniture:** One wooden table (3 ft x 2 ft) with cover, two chairs will be supplied. No electric plug point (socket) shall be provided. No stove / gas connection shall be permitted. Participants to bring their own utensils and serving plates. No special request will be allowed. Drinking water will be available in the pandal.
7. The judge's decision will be final and binding on all. The management committee of PRANTIC CULTURAL SOCIETY shall not be responsible for any unsold food items or quality of foods sold by the participants.

### GROUP DANCE

1. **Registration fees:** NIL
2. **Theme:** Group dance representing "INDIAN CULTURAL HERITAGE"
3. **Time duration for each group dance team:** 5 minutes (maximum limit)
4. **Number of participants (dancers) in the group:** 6 - 8
5. **Reporting time for dance group at the venue:** 7.00 PM
6. **Sound and light:** The Group dance Coordinator can guide the available sound and light system at the pandal. No special request will be entertained
7. **Music:** Pen-drive /CD /DVD in MP3 format only. No live music will be allowed. Mp3 Track in Pen drive to be handed over to the event co-coordinator of Prantic Cultural Society by 17<sup>th</sup> September 2017

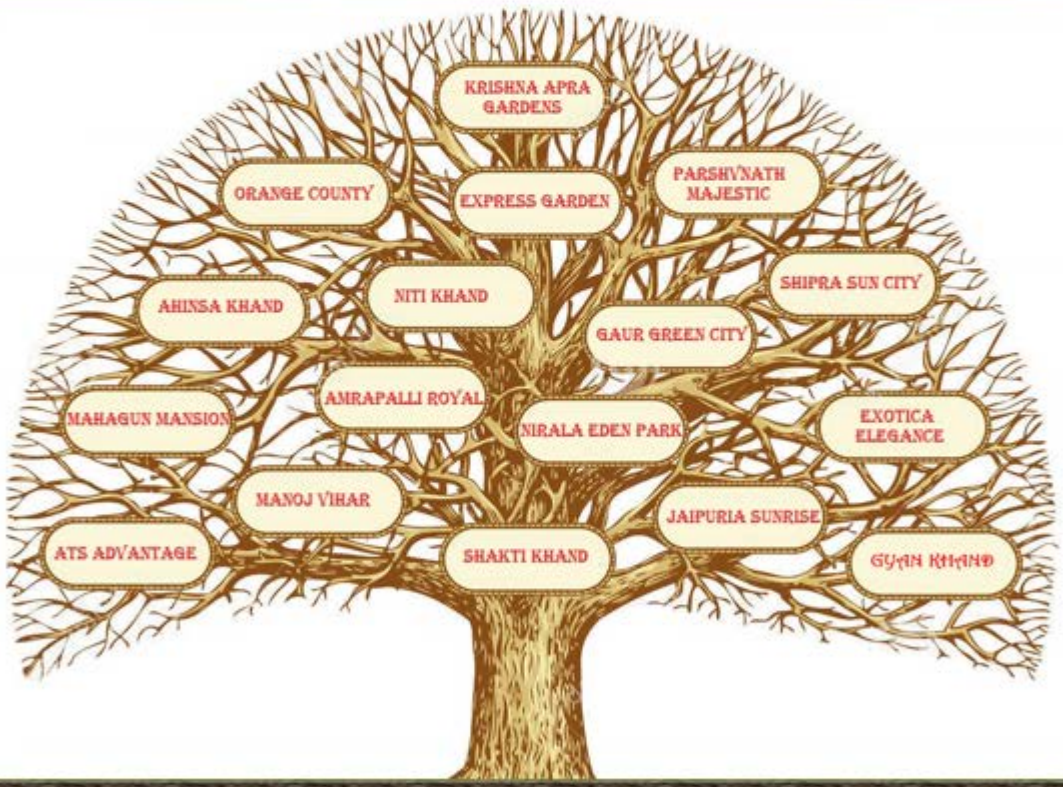
